Project Overview

Newark City School District recently completed two athletic facility improvement projects aimed at enhancing student recreation and community engagement. INCompliance provided Owner's Representative Services for the construction of a new band turf field and six new tennis courts.

The turf field project involved the demolition of three existing tennis courts and the installation of 85.5K square feet of synthetic turf, lined for both football and soccer use. The tennis court project transformed a grass field into six side-by-side courts with a 15-foot extended viewing area, totaling about 40.5K square feet. A black vinyl chain-link fence was installed around the perimeter to ensure safety and durability.

Throughout both three-month projects, INCompliance led bi-weekly progress meetings, reviewed pay applications and change orders, and provided consistent oversight to maintain budget and schedule alignment. Our team also supported the Owner through project closeout, including punch list management and verification of final documentation and training.
